James A. Rademacher, DMD, Ph.D

James Arno Rademacher, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend, passed away Jan. 4, 2010.

Jim attended Portland public schools and graduated from Washington High School in 1961. He attended the University of Oregon where he joined the Phi Gamma Delta fraternity; Portland State University; and the University of Oregon Dental School where he received his DMD degree in 1970. Jim continued his education at Georgetown University Medical School and then graduated in 1976 with a doctorate degree in anatomy from the University of Oregon Medical School. His love of learning continued throughout his life with active participation in professional study groups and an ongoing practice based research project. In addition to his general practice, he was a well-known specialist in treating TMJ disorders. He had just finished preparing a presentation of the findings he compiled over his 35 years of treating TMJ patients.

Jim joined his father, Arno J. Rademacher, in 1976 and practiced dentistry in the Mt. Tabor neighborhood until May 2009, when his illness forced his early retirement.

As a dentist and TMJ disorder specialist, Jim took much pride in his work. Much to the consternation of his office staff who worked to keep him on schedule, Jim was never in a hurry when it came to patient care. He put relationships first and his patients knew they could expect a full conversation about music, concerts, the Blazers, current affairs, politics or the environment as part of their appointment. These conversations were as important to him as the care he provided.

Jim is survived by his wife Jo Ellen and three children; Richard, Emily and Peter, Sister Deann and grandson Andrew.

I would like to pass on a warning to the other Society members, which they can also pass on to their patients. There is an online teeth whitener that is a scam. I ordered a sample when it was called Dazzle White, but it is now called Premium White. The company sends you a "free" sample, but if you aren't very careful you get billed for additional shipments at high cost. They also sign you up for other billable offers, even if you decline them. They operate under numerous names (EzySteps, Elitepack, VHAccess, PristineHealth, UltiFreshWill, AccessMember), so it easy to miss the charges on your credit card statement. The Better Business Bureau gives them a very poor rating. I have been charged almost \$400 in trying their "free" sample and they will not do refunds.
